## **Important Information**

- Fishing is dawn till dusk only (no night fishing)
- All anglers must possess a current, valid UK fishing license
- Every bait in moderation (nuts and pulses banned)
- All fish must be returned, no keepnets
- 2 rods maximum
- · Barbless hooks
- 1 person per peg



## **Species of fish**

Carp up to 10lb Tench and bream up to 1lb Crucian Carp up to 1lb

Not suitable for specimen carp anglers. This is for less serious anglers looking for fun.

## Lake information

- Must hold UK rod license and day tickets purchased before starting
- The majority of fish have never been caught and have never been fished before
- $\bullet\,$  Pegs 8, 9 & 10 are ideal to cast to the far side of the lake
- All other pegs mostly suit underhand carp fished up to reeds and overhanging trees
- · Remove all rubbish and broken lines

Lake depth: 2-4 feet

**Pegs:** 13 ( on the map )

Size: Small



- Best baits:
  Soft pellets, corn and maggots
- Best methods:
   Float fishing close for the small fish and ledger, method feeder for larger species
- Use method feeder or PVA sticks





## **Species of fish**

Carp up to 32lbs, Tench up to 8lbs Bream up to 8lbs, Pike up to 25lbs Roach up to 2lbs

## Lake information

- Must hold UK rod license and day ticket purchased before starting
- Pegs 1-5 are closest to the main entertainment complex. Please consider that this area is used for our sports and leisure activities.
- Pegs 6-22 are more suited to carp anglers.
   They provide a bigger and longer casting area for overhand cast
- Pegs 23-30 are reedy with a shorter range for stealth fishing and mostly underarm casting
- There is car parking available for pegs 1-5 however no parking to the left of the dotted line
- Fishing Lake is the most challenging lake we have at Tattershall Lakes.
- All species of fish stocked although mostly carp from 2lb to double figures
- Remove all rubbish and broken lines

- Best baits:
  Palony or boilies
- Best methods:
   Float fishing close for the small fish and ledger, method feeder for larger species
- Use method feeder or PVA sticks
- **Best pegs:** 9 20
- Watch Carp Patrolling between pegs 25 32




## **Species of fish**

Carp up to 28lbs Pike up to 20lbs Tench up to 8lbs Bream up to 4lbs Perch up to 3lbs Rudd up to 2lbs Roach up to 2lbs

## Lake information

- Must hold UK rod license and day ticket purchased before starting
- Rudd Lake is a mature lake, with various specimens
- With only 7 pegs, we advise getting there early to avoid disappointment
- $\bullet$  Access to Rudd Lake is from Anglers Acre
- Parking is available behind all pegs
- Stage stands or pods for carp fishing
- Throughout summer, fish love mixers offers the top and also ziggs
- Remove all rubbish and broken lines

Lake depth: 4-7 feet

**Pegs:** 7 ( on the map )

Size: 2 acres

# Top tips

#### • Best Baits:

For Tench and Carp luncheon meat, worms, sweetcorn and boilies. For smaller fish, maggots and castors.

#### • Best Methods:

Float fishing close for the smaller fish and leger method feeder for the large species. Pike are caught by spinning during winter months.

- Use method feeder or PVA sticks
- Sit in one of the corner pegs and cast up the side of the bank or underneath the trees. Use 10mm Boilies for attacking the larger fish at around a foot deep with a strung out rig.

We have a very experienced carp angler working for us here at Tattershall Lakes. He has set up his own Facebook page, which you can like by searching **D&T Carping** and regularly fishes our lakes and others in the area. The page provides updates on what is being caught, baits and methods that are proving successful.

## Things to note:

We respectfully ask that all anglers or guests wishing to fish the lakes purchase fishing permits prior to fishing. These can be obtained from the Guest Services building located next to the main Merlin Entertainment Complex or at Leisure Services within the Merlin Entertainment Complex. If you are planning to fish early, we kindly request tickets are purchased the day before.

**Polite reminder:** All anglers are required to possess a UK rod licence as the park is often inspected by enforcement officers. If you are new to fishing, more details can be

Tattershall Lakes is not a commercial fishery and we respectfully advise that it is called "fishing" and not "catching". Many of our fish will be in excellent condition. Some may never have been caught before and we feel make a far better experience to catch a good condition quality fish, but perhaps in smaller quantities. However, there are many conditions that affect the fish and if they are feeding or not. This is out of the parks control and we cannot give refunds on day tickets purchased.



## **Important Information**

Please read carefully

All anglers are expected to pay for their fishing, there are no collective agreements where anglers aren't expected to pay. Please don't leave your fishing gear unattended as this is causing damage to our wildlife.

Rod Licences - It is lawful for all anglers to hold a UK rod licence. The authorities carry out random checks at the park in effort to enforce this.

Weed - All the lakes will have a presence of weed. This is a natural occurrence, although does provide a more challenging session for anglers. However, those anglers with some knowledge will be able to change their fishing styles and bait to amend each lake and session. The weed helps provide cover for fish, oxygenate the water and provides a natural habitat for the fish and other species of wildlife that habit the lake.









## **Lake Developments**

Over the last two years we have introduced over £12,000 of fish into our lakes. Half of which are carp weighing around 3lb per fish. These fish have provided good quality leisure fishing, for both guests and owners. At Tattershall Lakes we believe in regular up-keep in our lakes and fish to make sure you have the best experience whether an experienced angler, or a first time fisherman!

Thirteen of our *Luxury lakeside lodges* have fishing pegs at the front of the lodges.

Anglers must possess a valid UK rod licence.
